

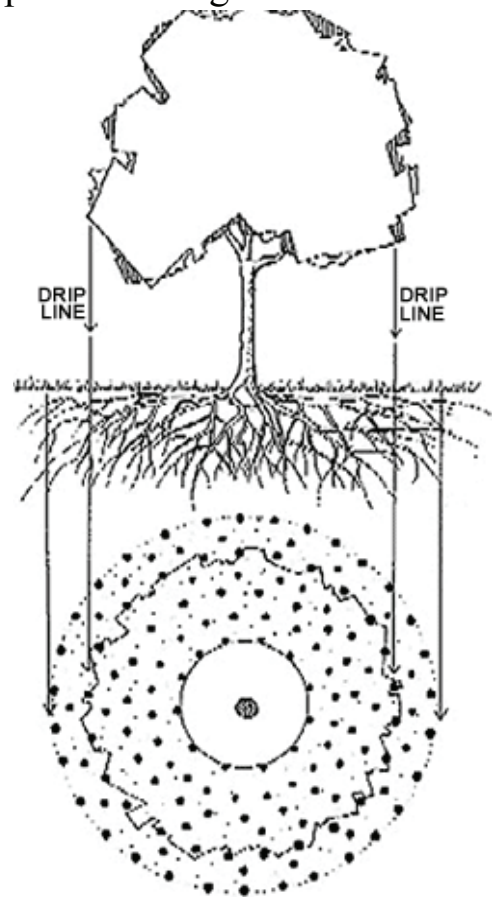
Deep Root Watering & Feeding of Trees

Deep root feeding and watering of trees is very essential to the growth and strong root bases of all trees. The key is to develop holes in the earth above the root system that go down 18 inches.

Deep root feeding is an important application for helping plants recover from stressful situations. Time matters in deep root feeding. When fertilizer is applied, it will affect what part of the tree develops and when. Deep root feeding applied in the spring will encourage tip and leaf growth. Deep root feeding in the fall develops the trees root base.

Deep root feeding is a process in which your tree professional will use a large spike to plunge into the tree's root ball and fertilizer is pumped through the spike and into the deep soil. It is best to use a professional in doing a deep root feeding because the higher the pressure the greater the spread of nutrients throughout the root system.

The time of year the fertilizer is applied will make a difference in what part of the tree it affects.
