Spider Barrier Fact Sheet

Spiders entering your home can present a problem and be a nuisance! Some spiders are beneficial as they prey on other insects in the home, but other spiders, such as Hobo's, Brown Recluse and Black Widows are poisonous and have the potential to cause physical harm.

Living Water provides a SOLUTION to combat spiders:

Spider Barrier Application: this is a sprayed application which is applied to the exterior of the house. We treat the foundation, cracks, doors, windows and under the eaves. This creates a barrier that the spider crosses over, picks up the product on its legs, cleans itself, ingests the product and is controlled. If you already have spiders in your home, the Department of Agriculture recommends purchasing spider traps versus bug bombs. If you choose to use a bug bomb, be certain to read and follow the directions on the label. Either may be purchased at your local hardware store and are most successful when used simultaneously with a barrier spray.

The spider barrier spray cost **\$49.95** per application, Duplexes and apartment buildings are on a per quote basis. Out of area, such as Cheney, Deer Park, Medical Lake, Colbert, or Greenbluff start at \$59.95. A single application is guaranteed for 30-45 days (depending on the time of year) We suggest our complete program of four applications, one in the spring, one in the summer, one in late summer and one in the fall, **for season long guaranteed results.**
